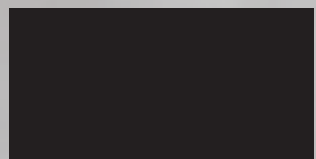

Baghdad: A Battleground for Press, Diplomats and Soliders alike

October alone, hundreds of civilians were killed or injured in bombings and shootings across Baghdad and other major cities. The humanitarian crisis is severe, with millions of Iraqis displaced, lacking access to basic necessities such as clean water, healthcare, and education.

Fatima al-Sudani, a resident of Baghdad, shared her harrowing experience. "We live in constant fear. There is no safe place anywhere. Every time we hear an explosion, we wonder if our loved ones are safe. It's a nightmare that never ends."

The Iraqi government, plagued by corruption and sectarian divisions, struggles to maintain control and provide basic services. Prime Minister Nouri al-Maliki faces criticism for his inability to

Once the cradle of civilization, Iraq has now become a nightmare battlefield. The ongoing conflict, which began with the U.S.-led invasion in 2003, has left the country in a state of perpetual violence and instability. The complexities of sectarian strife, insurgent attacks, and political turmoil continue to ravage the nation, with no clear end in sight.

The landscape of Iraq is marred by daily bombings, kidnappings, and sectarian killings. The insurgency, led by various groups, including Al-Qaeda in Iraq, continues to challenge the fragile Iraqi government and coalition forces. Despite significant military efforts, the insurgents' guerrilla tactics and rooted networks make a persistent threat.

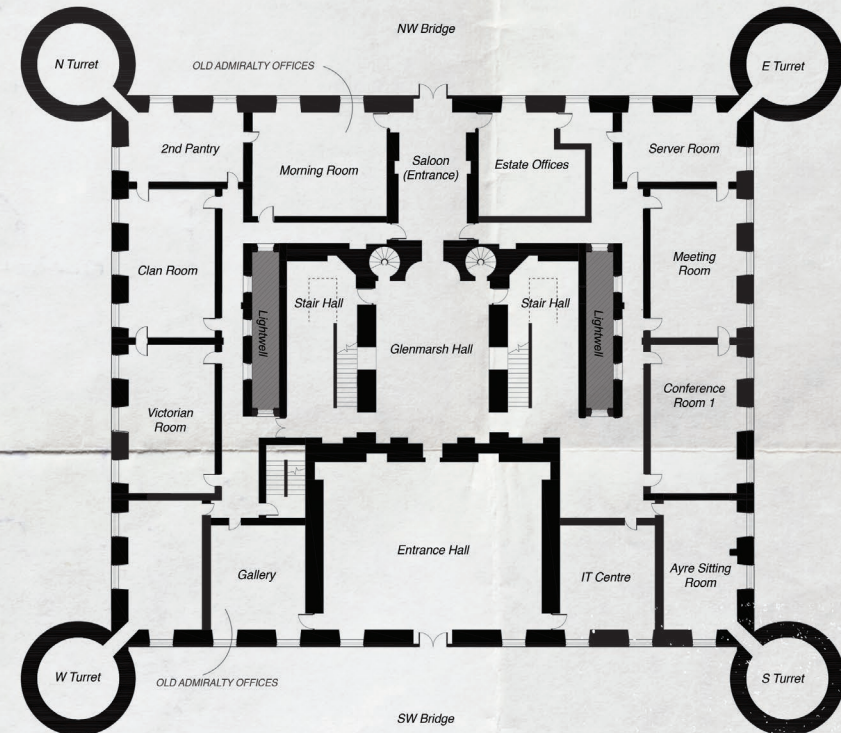
THE CONSERVATION OF ARCHITECTURAL ANCIENT MONUMENTS IN SCOTLAND

(b) any works for the purpose of removing or repairing a scheduled monument or any part of it or of making any alterations or additions thereto; and

(c) any flooding or tipping operations on land in, on or under which there is a scheduled monument.



FIRST FLOOR PLAN

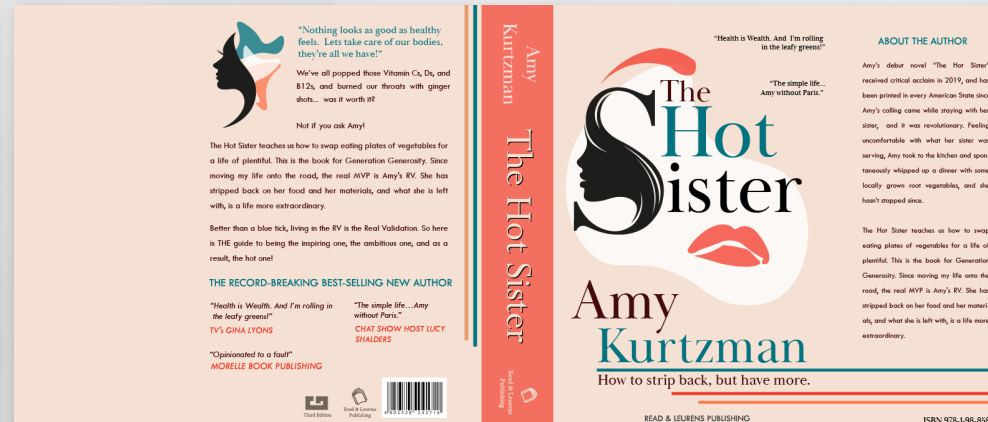
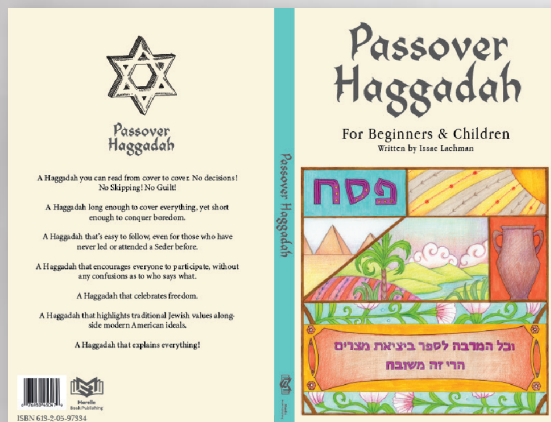
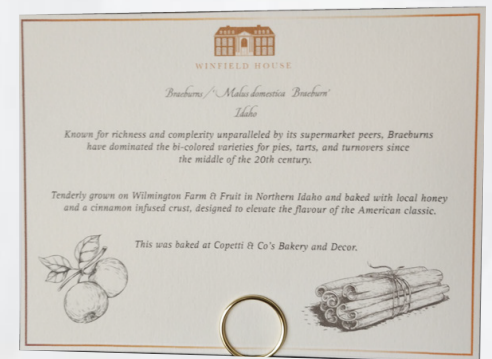
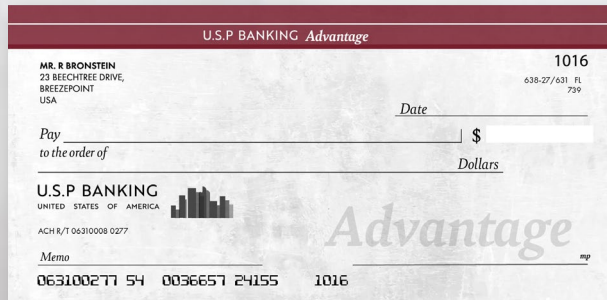
